



HOW DO WE LIVE AT PEACE WITH OTHERS AND HONOR GOD?

BIBLE STORY: Belief and Behavior (1 Timothy 2:1-7)

BIBLE TRUTH: God enables us to live out our faith so that we can point others to Jesus.

BIBLE VERSE: So that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity.
1 Timothy 2:2b

BONUS VERSE: Jesus did this, the first of his signs, in Cana of Galilee. He revealed his glory, and his disciples believed in him. *John 2:11*

This week we answered the question, “How do we live at peace with others and honor God?” We discussed how God equips and helps us live in obedience to Him. As believers our lives are marked by transformation as we become more like Jesus.

Our Bible story came from 1 Timothy 2:1-7. There was a lot of arguing in the Ephesian church. People were debating things that didn’t really matter and they were forgetting about what being a Christian is all about: following Jesus. We don’t need to argue with people even when we disagree with them. God calls us to live in peace with others. Of course that doesn’t mean we shouldn’t speak the truth. We are called to be witnesses of the truth of Christ, but we can do so in a peaceful way. God enables us to live out our faith so that we can point others to Jesus. When our lives are peaceful, others know that Jesus is the one who brings peace.

This week pray with your child that God would help him or her to live in peace with others. Ask your child to tell you if there are people he or she knows who are hard to live in peace with. Pray for those people and ask God to work in their hearts. We want our kids to know that God transforms our lives when we put our faith in Jesus. Read Galatians 5:22 together and help your child list the fruit of the spirit. Help your TeamKID see that when we are joined to Jesus, our lives will reflect what He is like.
