

A Spiritual Cancer **Deuteronomy 13:1-5**

In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace.

Eph 1:7 (NIV)

A slave is not a permanent member of the family, but a son is part of the family forever. So if the Son sets you free, you are truly free. **Joh 8:35-36** (NLT)

A. Acknowledge the threat of sin **v. 1-2**

1. The influence of sin

For false christs and false prophets will rise and show signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. **Mark 13:22** (NKJV)

2. The infection of sin

Temptation comes from our own desires, which entice us and drag us away. These desires give birth to sinful actions. And when sin is allowed to grow, it gives birth to death. **James 1:14-15** (NLT)

B. Walk with Christ who conquered sin **v. 3-4**

But it is good for me to draw near to God: I have put my trust in the Lord GOD, that I may declare all thy works. **Psalms 73:28** (KJV)

C. Deal drastically with your sin **v. 5**

1. Remove all sin **v. 5, 8-11, 14-15**

2. Do what is right **v. 17-18**
