

# Wednesday Explore the Bible Team

## Expectations & Responsibilities

### Overview

Explore the Bible is a midweek discipleship time for children 3yrs-6th grade. It will help kids and preschoolers read and study God's Word book by book in a way that is interactive and age-appropriate. It will help lay the foundation for how they will encounter God's Word at Coral Hill as a student and then as an adult, primarily through expositional preaching and teaching.

### Team Leader Expectations

### Team Responsibilities

1. Be prepared to Teach/Assist students ages 3 years old – 6th grade
2. Supervise children in your care from the time a parent/guardian checks them in until the parent/guardian checks them out

### Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. What time am I expected to serve? to arrive?**
  - a. Please be in your classroom by 5:50pm on Wednesdays
  - b. Please be prepared to stay until 7:30pm
- 2. What is the church's policy regarding children checking in?** Students are required to be checked in by a parent/guardian and wear a badge. Once the parents/guardians bring them to the classroom door, we are responsible until the parents come back to pick their child up to go home.
- 3. Will I be responsible to provide snacks?** No. However, if you'd like to offer a snack on a given week please plan with the ETB Coordinators
- 4. Will I need to complete a background check and training??** Every Explore the Bible volunteer will need to complete a background check and child safety training (video and assessment)
