



HOW DO I KNOW MORE ABOUT THE BIBLE?

BIBLE STORY: Believe the Truth (2 Timothy 2:1-26)

BIBLE TRUTH: God helps me grow strong in my faith.

BIBLE VERSE: Be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. *2 Timothy 2:1*

Your preschooler is learning that God helps us grow strong in our faith. She learned, "Be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus" (2 Timothy 2:1)." Reinforce this truth by sharing ways you serve in the church and how you work to get along with others.

Paul encouraged Timothy to keep doing the work of leading the church in learning about Jesus. Paul exhorted Timothy to faithfully teach believers the truth of the Word, but to be a gentle and patient teacher, recognizing that God is the One who helps them know the truth.

Timothy was like a son to Paul. They had traveled together telling people about Jesus. Paul had taught Timothy many things about Jesus. He encouraged Timothy to teach others what Paul had taught him. He said, "Keep working hard. Be like a soldier who obeys his commanding officer. Work as a worker for Jesus. God will help you."

As believers, we need to remember that everything in the Bible is true. Only two things last forever, the souls of men and the Word of God (the Bible). The Bible has no errors or mistakes in it. God has given us His Word so that we can know how He wants us to live. He gives us what we need to practice healthy habits of growing in our faith.

Take some time to sit down and read the Bible with your preschooler. Talk about how the Bible is true and every story in it really happened. Encourage her to ask questions about the Bible and things she may not understand. If you don't know how to answer her questions, don't be ashamed to be honest, and then find the answers for her.

Try to establish (or continue) a habit of reading God's Word and praying on a daily basis. This will help you grow in your faith and help you lead your child to do the same
