## THE ANOINTING

TODAY'S POINT: I CAN SHOW JESUS I LOVE HIM.

Thank You, God, for Jesus. Luke 2:38

#### **BIBLE STORY**

Jesus Was Anointed (John 12:1-8)

## **KEY POINTS**

- Mary worshiped Jesus with her whole heart.
- When we know with our minds and believe in our hearts that Jesus is the Son of God, that changes how we live.
- God wants us to worship Him with our heart, mind, soul, and strength.

KEY VERSE: Luke 2:38

**FAMILY READING** 

John 12:1-8

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Why did Mary pour the perfume on Jesus' feet? (She did it to show how much she loved Him. She worshiped Him.)
- What did Jesus say when the disciple asked why Mary didn't sell the perfume and give the money to the poor? (He said Mary had given Him a very special gift, and it was a good thing. Jesus knew Mary did it because she loved Him.)
- Jesus is worthy of all our worship!

## SESSION 29 PARENT CONNECTION

# THE KING

TODAY'S POINT: PEOPLE WELCOMED JESUS TO JERUSALEM.

Children cheered, "Hosanna," when they saw Jesus. Matthew 21:15

### **BIBLE STORY**

Jesus Entered Jerusalem (Luke 19:28-44; Matthew 21:1-1; Mark 14:1-26; John 12:12-19)

#### **KEY POINTS**

- Jesus came into Jerusalem on a donkey, just like was promised in the Old Testament.
- The people welcomed Jesus to Jerusalem like they would a king, but they didn't understand that Jesus is the King God promised.
- We can worship Jesus as the true King.

**KEY VERSE:** Matthew 21:15

### **FAMILY READING**

Matthew 21:1-11 (Retell in words preschoolers can understand.)

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- What city did Jesus ride into? (Jerusalem)
- How did the people welcome Jesus? (Shouting Hosanna and praising Him)
- How can we worship Jesus as the King God promised to send?

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## SESSION 30 PARENT CONNECTION

# THE LAST SUPPER

TODAY'S POINT: JESUS SHOWED HIS HELPERS HOW TO HELP OTHERS.

Jesus said, "Do for others like I have done for you." John 13:15

#### **BIBLE STORY**

Jesus and the Last Supper (Matthew 26:17-30; Mark 14:1-26; Luke 22:14-23; John 13:1-20)

#### **KEY POINTS**

- Washing feet was something a servant did when people came to someone's home.
- Jesus washed His disciples' feet as an example of serving others.
- Even though Jesus is God's Son, He showed His disciples (helpers) that they should help others just like He did.

KEY VERSE: John 13:15

#### **FAMILY READING**

John 13:3-5,12-17 (Retell in words preschoolers can understand.)

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- Why did servants need to wash the guests' feet? (The roads were dusty and most people wore sandals. Their feet were usually very dirty.)
- Why did Jesus wash His disciples' (helpers') feet? (To show them how to serve others; to remind them not to think of themselves as better than others.)
- What are some things you can do to serve others like Jesus did? Consider washing your children's feet as an example.



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## SESSION 31 PARENT CONNECTION

# GOD'S KINGDOM HAS COME

TODAY'S POINT: JESUS FOLLOWED GOD'S PLAN FOR HIM.

Jesus talked to God. John 17:1

#### **BIBLE STORY**

Jesus Prayed in the Garden (Luke 22:39-46; Matthew 26:36-46; Mark 14:32-42)

#### **KEY POINTS**

- Jesus was sad. He knew things were going to be hard.
- Jesus knew He could talk to God. Even though Jesus was sad, He knew God loved Him.
- Jesus knew God had a special plan for Him. He followed that plan no matter what.

KEY VERSE: John 17:1

#### **FAMILY READING**

Matthew 26:36-44 (Retell in words preschoolers can understand.)

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- Why did Jesus pray in the Garden?
  (He was sad and knew things were going to be hard. He wanted to talk to God.)
- Have you ever been sad and wanted to talk to someone? Who did you talk to?
- God hears us when we pray. What are some things that you and your family can talk to God about?



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## SESSION 32 PARENT CONNECTION

# THE KING

TODAY'S POINT: JESUS IS ALIVE!

Jesus is alive! Matthew 28:7

## **BIBLE STORY**

Jesus' Death and Resurrection (Luke 24:1-12; Matthew 28:1-10; Mark 16:1-13; John 20:1-23)

### **KEY POINTS**

- Jesus had died and His body was placed in a tomb.
- After three days Mary went to the tomb, but it was empty! She was sad because she didn't know where Jesus was. Mary didn't know that Jesus had come back to life.
- Jesus talked to Mary. Jesus told her to go tell His friends that He is alive!

KEY VERSE: Matthew 28:7

### **FAMILY READING**

Matthew 28:1-10 (Retell in words that preschoolers can understand.)

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- Why wasn't Jesus in the tomb? (He had come back to life!)
- Is Jesus alive today? (Yes! He lives in heaven.)
- What did Jesus tell Mary to do? (Tell His friends that He is alive.) Who are some people you can tell that Jesus is alive?



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## SESSION 33 PARENT CONNECTION

## THE PROMISE KEPT

TODAY'S POINT: JOHN TOLD PEOPLE ABOUT JESUS.

Jesus is God's Son. John 20:31

#### **BIBLE STORY**

Jesus Is Alive (Luke 24:1-12; Matthew 28:1-10; Mark 16:1-13; John 20:1-23)

#### **KEY POINTS**

- Jesus was raised from the dead. He had power over death.
- Mary ran to tell the disciples (helpers).
  Just like Mary said, they saw the tomb was empty!
- Jesus kept His promise that He would die and rise again.

KEY VERSE: John 20:31

#### **FAMILY READING**

Luke 24:1-12 (Retell in words that preschoolers can understand.)

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- What did the women find at the tomb that surprised them? (The tomb was empty.)
- What did Jesus tell Mary to do? (Go tell the disciples [helpers].) What did the disciples do when they heard? (Ran back to the tomb to see for themselves.)
- Why is it important that Jesus is alive? (He showed His power over death. He kept His promise. We can know He will keep His promises to us.)



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## SESSION 34 PARENT CONNECTION

## THE PROMISE FULFILLED

TODAY'S POINT: THE WHOLE BIBLE TELLS ABOUT JESUS.

The Bible is true. John 17:17

### **BIBLE STORY**

Jesus Appeared to His Disciples (Luke 24:13-49; John 20:24-30)

#### **KEY POINTS**

- After Jesus came back to life, He walked with two men. He told the men that everything in the Scriptures that was written about Him had come true.
- Jesus later proved that He was alive by showing the disciples (helpers) His hands and feet.
- The whole Bible is true and points us to Jesus.

KEY VERSE: John 17:17

### **FAMILY READING**

Luke 24:36-44

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- What did Jesus eat when He was with the disciples? (Fish)
- How do you think the disciples (helpers) felt when they saw Jesus? (Afraid; then happy)
- Thomas, one of the helpers, didn't believe that Jesus was alive at first.
   When you have doubts about Jesus, what can you do?



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## SESSION 35 PARENT CONNECTION

# THE RESTORATION

TODAY'S POINT: JESUS WILL ALWAYS LOVE ME.

Yes, Jesus, You know that I love You. John 21:16

### **BIBLE STORY**

Jesus Forgives and Restores (John 21)

### **KEY POINTS**

- Jesus proved again that He is God's Son when He helped the disciples (helpers) catch a lot of fish.
- Jesus' friend, Peter, had made a lot of mistakes. Jesus let Peter know that He still loved Peter.
- We can know that Jesus will always love us no matter what.

KEY VERSE: John 21:16

#### **FAMILY READING**

John 21:1-17 (Retell in words that preschoolers can understand.)

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- How many times did Jesus ask Peter if he loved Him? (Three)
- What did Jesus tell Peter to do? (Jesus told Peter to follow Him and to take care of His sheep. This meant that Jesus wanted Peter to watch over the people who loved and followed Jesus.)
- What are some ways we can show that we love Jesus?



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## SESSION 36 PARENT CONNECTION

# THE PROMISE CONTINUED

TODAY'S POINT: WE CAN TELL OTHERS ABOUT JESUS.

Go and tell others about Jesus. Matthew 28:19-20

#### **BIBLE STORY**

The Great Commission (Luke 24:50-53; Matthew 28:16-20; Mark 16:14-20)

### **KEY POINTS**

- Jesus wanted the disciples (helpers) to go out and tell others the good news of God's love.
- Jesus promises to be with us always and help us obey God.
- Jesus was taken up into heaven and is with God, but one day He will come back for us!

KEY VERSE: Matthew 28:19-20

## **FAMILY READING**

Matthew 28:16-20

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- What did Jesus tell His disciples (and us) to do? (Go and tell others about Him.)
- What did Jesus promise His disciples?
  (He would always be with them.)
- What are some ways we can obey Jesus' instructions to go and tell others about Him?
