Expectations & Responsibilities

Overview

The Sign Language Team serves to provide ASL interpretation of Sunday morning service.

Team Leader Expectations

1. Provide a monthly schedule for Sign Language Team volunteers.
2. Send a text reminder to your respective Sign Language Team members prior to the Sunday they are scheduled to serve.
3. Provide any necessary training/orientation to your volunteers and actively seek additional people to serve throughout the course of the year.

Team Responsibilities

1. Follow the mission of our church.
2. Provide sign language interpretation for service and/or church event as assigned.
3. Contact ASL Team Leader with any questions or needs by calling or texting the number provided.
4. Contact ASL Team Leader as soon as possible if unable to serve assigned day to provide sufficient time to schedule another volunteer or fill responsibility.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. **What time am I expected to serve? to arrive?** Provide interpretation at the 9:00 am service Please arrive no later than 8:45 am

Additional Expectations

1. Interpreters should wear solid color top (preferably a dark color)
2. Minimize jewelry so not to be distracting from interpreting
3. Songs and sermon are emailed by worship team leader to interpreter prior to service so preparation can be made
